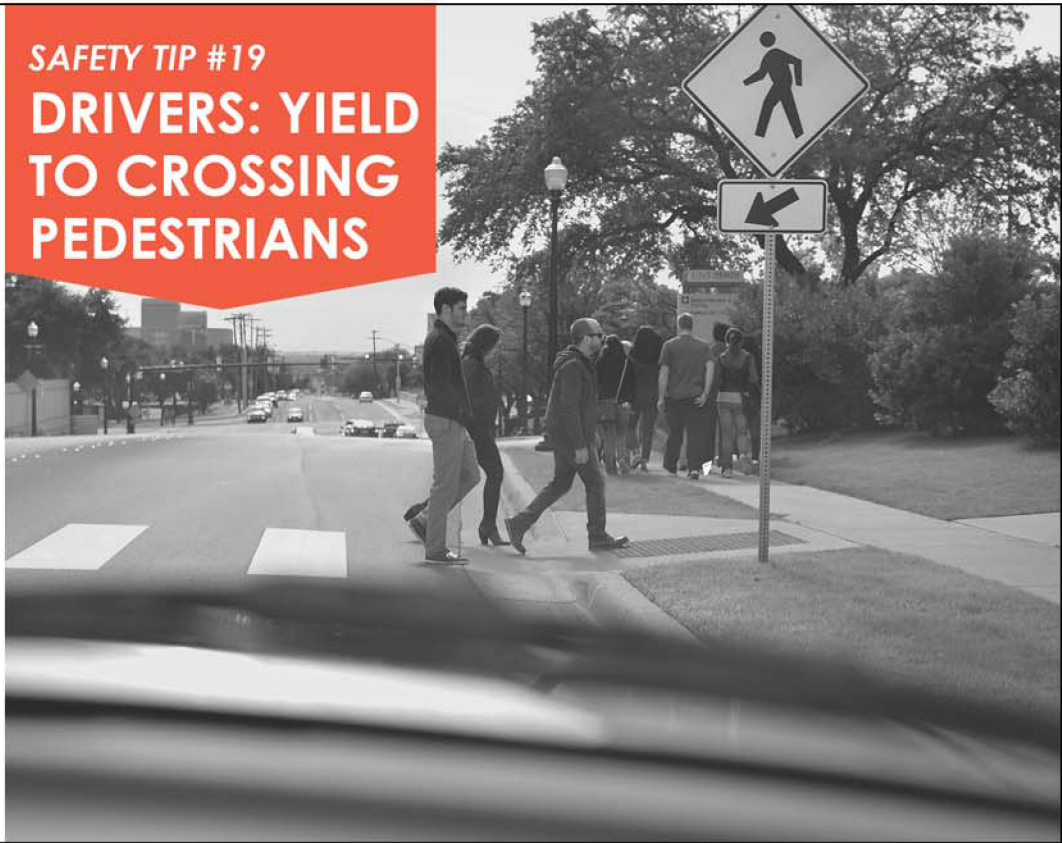
As a driver, never block or park in a crosswalk.
