

CROSS THE STREET AT INTERSECTIONS

When walking, it is important to be visible and look out for cars. Look left, right and left again before crossing the street and make eye contact with drivers to ensure you were seen.

The safest place to cross a street is a marked crosswalk. Do not cross between parked vehicles or vehicles waiting at traffic signals.
